The mission of Animal Aid Unlimited is to rescue and treat the un-owned street animals of India who have become ill or injured, and through their rescue inspire a community to protect and defend the lives of all animals.

We operate one of India's most active rescue services, responding to more than 70 calls on our helpline every day and involving thousands of Udaipur residents in the process of rescuing street animals every year. Our hospital and sanctuary (located in Badi, 10km from Udaipur) house a total of more than 600 animals (dogs, cows, donkeys, cats and other animals).

General purpose of the role

The veterinary doctor performs spay/neuter, amputations, eye enucleations, tumour removal, wound repairs and other surgeries; oversees and coordinates the Animal Birth Control program; and works in a team with Animal Aid's medical staff to ensure that the animals always receive the best treatment possible adhering to the organisation's protocols.

Training will be provided. Both junior and senior candidates are encouraged to apply.

Key area of responsibility

- 1. Perform spay and neuter (approx. 5-10 per day), amputations and other surgeries on daily basis
- 2. Monitor patients' post-operative recovery, tracking infection rates and any other complications
- 3. Monitor AACT's dog animal birth control programme ensuring humane and effective population control and rabies eradication
- 4. Liaison with relevant governmental and non-governmental bodies in relation to the ABC programme.
- 5. Report regularly to the management and prepare written reports as required
- 6. Ensure Animal Aid's protocols are followed and the utmost care is given to each and every patient
